**COMMITMENT**

A minimum of one 2-3 hour tattoo removal clinic shift a month. Willingness to respond to occasional e-mail or phone questions about laser issues or patient problems.

**PURPOSE**

Provide medical direction for Project Erase, a tattoo removal program for clients with gang, drug, hate, criminal and domestic violence related tattoos in the clinic commensurate to training and privileges. All volunteers should be comfortable working with a broad range of patients.

**DUTIES**

- Maintain an environment conducive to patient comfort and confidentiality.
- Communicate clearly and openly with clinic coordinators and tattoo removal doctors.
- Be familiar with laser removal and the electronic medical records at our clinic.
- Develop standard of care for Project Erase.
- It is of utmost importance that all volunteers are constantly aware and observant of sensitivity issues and concerns, and that their actions and attitudes reflect this understanding.
- Consult with Project Erase Clinic Coordinator and Outside In Clinic Manager regarding laser maintenance needs, laser protocols, and patient concerns on an as needed basis.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

- Licensed physician in state of Oregon with no legal actions against license.
- Minimum of one year out of residency if working unsupervised.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Able to handle multiple tasks and crisis situations.
- Must pass training on using the laser (offered by Outside In) and be familiar with all details about how it functions.
- Must be a fast learner, and be able to stay calm in difficult situations.
- Able to work with people from diverse ethnic, cultural, socioeconomic and sexual preference backgrounds.
- Must be comfortable and compassionate with people from diverse backgrounds who may be drug affected, emotionally charged, and have a challenging presence.
- Able to work both independently and as a member of a team.
- Must pass background check.

**REQUIRED TRAININGS**

- Complete HIPAA training within first two weeks
- New Worker Orientation
- Blood Borne Pathogens

**RECOMMENDED TRAININGS**

- De-Escalation
- CPR/First Aid (minimal fee)
